BERGERAC SEC (dry white) *Petite Fugue*

SOILS:

Sandy, silty clay soils

GRAPE VARIETIES :



Grey Sauvignon : 70%
White Sauvignon : 30 %

WINEMAKING :

"Petite fugue" is a pleasure wine of Château le Payral. A selection is made on the plots of sauvignon and grey sauvignon: we harvest the grapes at optimal ripeness.

The must is first kept cold for 36 hours to give it more structure, then it is put into barrels, 1/3 new, where it will ferment thanks to indigenous yeasts. The ageing on lees with regular stirring lasts ten months. This wine presents a nose of white fruits such as pears, which we find in the taste with finesse and fleshiness... These notes of fruits are underlined by a touch of vanilla. It should be appreciated during meals with white meat, fish in sauce and cheeses and you will be charmed by the harmony of this "Petite fugue".

This wine can be kept from 6 to 10 years.
